


**Safety, accountability and communication should be consistent.**




**There has become a reliance on video cameras and I feel administrators, teachers and staff should be more visible in hallways through the day.**




**The safety of the school is compromised when parents are allowed to walk their child to the classroom. After the first day, students should walk**


